Defendant to pay restitution in the amount of SEVENTY ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY SIX (\$71,466) DOLLARS, and a Special Assessment of FIFTY (\$50.00) DOLLARS. Restitution to be paid upon his release from prison.
