When pressed for the reasons behind this view explained that Secretary Clinton's recent statement noting "limited engagement" with the MB had been seen in Egypt as evidence of a special relationship and an endorsement of an Egyptian religious state to help legitimize a religious state in Israel. He said the MB had exploited the statement to suggest that it had a "special relationship" with the U.S. in the same way as it had suggested to Egyptians that it had a special relationship with the Supreme Council of the Armed Forces (SCAF).	
4. (C) MinCons responded that a handful of meetings was hardly evidence of any endorsement or special relationship, and said the idea that the US was "supporting" a religious state led by the MB is absurd. He noted our clear, consistent and public support for democracy and religious freedom in Egypt and elsewhere.
