

**IN RE PUNISHMENT**


I, the undersigned District Attorney of the Twenty-first Judicial District, Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma, do upon my official oath further give the said Court to know and be informed that the offense of Murder in the First Degree as charged in Count 1 within the original information, was committed by the said Alton Alexander Nolen, named therein and should be punished by death, due to and as a result of the following aggravating circumstances, to wit:

1. The murder was especially heinous, atrocious, or cruel;
2. The defendant knowingly created a great risk of death to more than one person;
3. There exists a probability that the defendant will commit criminal acts of violence that would constitute a continuing threat to society;
4. The defendant was previously convicted of a felony involving the use or threat of violence to the person.
