On 5 May 2009, the United States Court of Appeals, Sixth Circuit, in United States v. Fayez Damra, Case No. 08-4540, granted defendant Fayez “Alex” Damra’s motion for release on bond pending appeal. The matter has been remanded to this Court with instructions to set the conditions for Mr. Damra’s bond during the pendency of his appeal.

The Court will impose the same conditions of release upon Mr. Damra as existed prior to his surrender to the U.S. Marshal Service. (Doc. 84, 20). Mr. Damra’s bond is set at \$500,000 unsecured, with the condition that Mr. Damra’s travel be restricted to the Northern District of Ohio and the District of Nevada.

The conditions of Mr. Damra’s release on bond pending appeal include the following:

- The defendant shall not commit any offense in violation of federal, state, or local law while on release in this case;

- The defendant shall immediately advise the Court, Pretrial Services, and the U.S. Attorney in writing before any change in address and/or telephone number;
- The defendant shall refrain from possessing a firearm, destructive device or dangerous weapon;
- Defendant's travel is restricted to the northern District of Ohio and the District of Nevada;
- Defendant shall refrain from use or unlawful possession of a narcotic drug or other controlled substance defined in 21 U.S.C. Section §802 unless prescribed by a licensed medical practitioner; and
- The defendant shall appear at all proceedings as required and shall surrender for service of any sentence imposed as directed;
- The defendant shall surrender any passport to the Clerk of Court.
- Defendant shall contact Pretrial Services in Nevada on a weekly basis and submit to home and/or employment visits by Pretrial Services as deemed necessary;
- Defendant shall submit to a verification of his residence;
- Defendant shall promptly inform Pretrial Services of any address, telephone number, or employment changes.
