PROCEEDINGS

REASON FOR HEARING: Sentencing Hearing – Held.

RESULT OF HEARING: Sentencing Hearing – HELD. The Court sentences the defendant to the custody of the BOP for a term of 235 months on Count 2; followed by 15 years supervised release with all standard and special conditions as stated on the record; \$100 special assessment; fine waived. Restitution is ordered in the amount of \$94,267.51.

The defendant shall forfeit to the United States the following property:

Any firearms, ammunition, explosive materials and devices, and explosives used in or seized in the investigations of the arsons committed from June 1, 2024, through June 16, 2024, including, but not limited to: six explosive devices commonly referred to as “Molotov cocktails” seized on or about June 1, 2024, and three Molotov cocktails seized on or about June 11, 2024.

The Court will make the following recommendations to the Bureau of Prisons that the defendant shall participate in the Bureau of Prison’s Residential Drug Abuse Treatment Program and the defendant will be designated to a facility that contains a Communication Management Unit.

Government’s oral Motion to dismiss Counts 1 and 3, is GRANTED.
