Counts 1 and 2: The defendant is hereby commitment to the custody of the Attorney General pursuant to 18 U.S.C § 4244 for a provisional life sentence on each of counts 1 and 2 to be concurrent with each other and if and when it is later determined that the defendant is no longer in need of treatment in a facility within the custody of the Attorney General, then the defendant will be remanded back the Court to have his sentence modified to 25 years in prison on each count concurrent with each other.

Supervised Release: 20 years.

Special Conditions of Supervised Release or Probation: see criminal judgment.

Restitution: N.A.

Fine: none imposed.

Special Assessment: \$200.00 due immediately.

The defendant was advised of his/her right to appeal within fourteen days ___✓___.

Recommendations to BOP: The defendant be placed at a federal medical center at either Rochester, Minnesota and Butner North Carolina and he received neurological and neuropsychological evaluations on a regular basis.
