
This matter having come before the Court upon the defendant's oral motion for preservation of evidence,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the government take all necessary and reasonable steps to preserve without any manner of alteration all recording devices, electronic storage mechanisms and media, or other materials, physical or electronic, regarding the recordation or attempted recordation of images, sounds, and written material in connection with this case

generated during the meeting of July 30, 2010, described at paragraph 37, page 14, of the affidavit in support of the arrest warrant and complaint.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the government take all necessary and reasonable steps to preserve without any manner of alteration all recorded material, including images and sounds, of meetings between the defendant and undercover employees, including recordings of the undercover employees captured prior to or following meetings with the defendant that do not specifically capture statements and images of the defendant.
