Dear Judge Tomlinson:

Please accept this letter as a correction/clarification to portions of our bail motion filed on March 24, 2020. We stated on page 2 of the motion that Mr. Redzepagic was “recently diagnosed with active tuberculosis having previously been a latent TB carrier”. After further and more detailed conversations with his family we believe that this TB history is somewhat inaccurate. We have been informed by his family that Mr. Redzepagic was diagnosed with active Tuberculosis as a child (at approximately age 5) and was admitted to Elmhurst Hospital for one month, following which he was treated on an outpatient basis for approximately one year. We are further informed that Mr. Redzepagic was recently tested for TB in jail and the test was positive. He had a mild physical reaction to the test.

We have also learned that Mr. Redzepagic’s family no longer live in Suffolk County as stated in our motion. Their current residence is in Queens.

Thank you for your expeditious consideration of this matter.
