ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation shall be Islamic Association for Palestine. (hereinafter referred to as "I.A.P.")

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation shall be a non-profit corporation.

The period of duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR
