

AWOL soldier gets arrested with suspicious materials

On July 26, 2011 the Killeen Police Department received information regarding suspicious activity.

The Killeen Police Department and the Fort Hood Criminal Investigations Division Command began an investigation into this report.



On July 27, 2011 at 2:03PM the Killeen Police Department arrested Naser Jason Abdo, an AWOL soldier from Fort Campbell, Kentucky on a warrant from the Fort Campbell Provost Marshall's Office charging him with Possession of Obscene Material and AWOL.

During the investigation suspicious materials were located in Abdo's hotel room. It is anticipated that Federal charges will be filed.

The Killeen Police Department would like to assure the citizens of Killeen and the surrounding area that we are not aware of any additional threats to the safety of our community.

The Killeen Police Department would also like to thank the US Army CID Command, the FBI's Joint Terrorism Task Force, the FBI, the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms, the McClennan County Sheriff's Office Bomb Squad, Fort Hood EOD, the Bell County District Attorney's Office, the US Attorney's Office and the Texas Department of Public Safety for their hard work in making the citizens of our community safer.
