

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation of such corporation :

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be : Islamic Concern Project Inc.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be : 5207 E. 127th Ave.
Tampa, FL 33617

ARTICLE II

The period of the duration of this corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to the law.

ARTICLE III

The purpose of which the corporation is organized are : Charitable, cultural, social, educational and religious in which the concept of brotherhood, freedom, justice, unity, piety, righteousness and peace shall be propagated. In addition the organization shall take human projects of helping the poor, the refugees, the displaced, the orphans, the sick, the handicapped and the homeless .

ARTICLE IV

The qualifications for members and the manner of their admission are :
(a) Strong adherence and belief in the goals and purpose of the organization .
(b) Spending -on average- 10 hours every month for voluntary community and organizational work .

ARTICLE V
