FELONY SENTENCING ORDER

This day again came the Attorney for the Commonwealth and the attorney for the defendant, as aforesaid, and came as well the defendant in person, who stands convicted of Possession of Cocaine as charged in the indictment and Possession of Marijuana as charged in the Warrant.

Thereupon the Probation Officer of this Court, to whom this case has been previously referred for investigation, appeared in open Court with a written report, a copy of which has been delivered to counsel for the defendant. Whereupon the defendant and his counsel were given the right to cross-examine the Probation Officer as to any matter contained in the said report and to present any additional facts bearing upon the matter as they desired to present. The report of the Probation Officer is hereby filed as a part of the record in this case. Whereupon the Court taking into consideration all of the evidence in the case, the report of the Probation Officer and such additional facts as were presented by the defendant, doth now fix the defendant's punishment at confinement in the City Jail for the term of Twelve Months for Possession of Cocaine as charged in the indictment and confinement in the City Jail for the term of 30 days for Possession of Marijuana as charged in the Warrant, and that he be required to pay the costs of his prosecution. The Court doth adjudge and order that the execution of Ten (10) months of the aforesaid Twelve Month jail sentence be suspended and the defendant be placed on One Year unsupervised probation, to commence upon release from confinement, conditioned upon good behavior and the payment of the Court costs. Thereupon the defendant noted his appeal and the Court doth fix bail bond in the amount of \$2,000.00 with surety. It is further ordered that the transcript of testimony, when prepared, be made a part of the record in this case. Date of Birth: [REDACTED] And the prisoner was remanded to jail.
