OFFENSE:

On February 1, 1981 Wright Bray, IV possessed cocaine, a scheduled II controlled substance.

On February 1, 1981 Wright Bray, IV possessed marijuana (misdemeanor).

Police Report:

Records in the Commonwealth's Attorney's file show that on February 1, 1981 at 12:30 a.m. at 719 East Ocean View Avenue in Norfolk, police officers observed a black female bending over a black male's lap, later identified as Wright Bray, IV, in a parked car. As Norfolk Police Officers approached the vehicle, they reportedly observed a hand-rolled cigarette of suspected marijuana in plain view and a packet of white powder, suspected cocaine. Bray was then ordered to open the door whereby according to the police report, "he ate the packet of white powder." Recovered was a one-half ounce bag of marijuana, a small mirror, and a straw with white powder residue. Subject was then arrested and charged with the instant offenses. The evidence was submitted to the Tidewater Laboratory of the Bureau of Forensic Science whereby the recovered green/brown plant material was found to contain eight grams of marijuana and the white residue from the straw was found to contain cocaine.

Defendant's Statement:

Subject advises that the marijuana was his property but that the cocaine belonged to his female companion. Bray accepts responsibility for his participation and actions in the instant offenses. He expressed remorse for his irresponsible behavior.
