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

llah, Most High, has emphatically declared to the believers that the life (*i.e.*, *sunnah*) of Prophet Muhammad (s) is a perfect concrete model for them to follow if they are to succeed with their mission in this life, and to attain salvation and the fulfillment of the purpose of life hereafter:

"Certainly you have in (the life) of the Messenger of Allah a beautiful model (of conduct) for anyone whose hope is in Allah and the Final Day (i.e., who looks with hope to Allah and to the Final Day) and who engages much in the zikr (remembrance) of Allah." (Qur'an: 33:21)

Whatever is authentic as *summah* is, of necessity, in conformity with the Qur'an. Aisha (ra) declared of the Prophet (s) that "his natural disposition or nature was an embodiment of the Qur'an". The companions of the Prophet (s) were, of course, assured that conformity with the summah implied, ipso facto, conformity with the Qur'an. This was so because the Prophet (s) was physically present in their midst. For us, however, who live in the post-Prophetic period (i.e., when the Prophet is no longer physically in our midst), the Qur'an has become the primary source of guidance, and this is why we have used the above-quoted Qur'anic verse to establish the abiding importance of the summah. And this underscores the need for the penetration of the Qur'anic guidance so that it may function as the very foundation and structure of Muslim society.

The Prophetic model has two basic dimensions; a) an individual/personal and b) a collective/public dimension. The first dimension would be that which relates to the Prophet's life in his personal/individual affairs and in his personal relationship with *Allah* and with the believers etc.; while the second would be that which relates to his conduct as the head of a community which he established. In order to conform with the Prophetic model Muslims must organize their lives in accordance with both dimensions of the
