In this *hadīth*, repeating the word 'indeed' serves to prove with certainty that the False Messiah will appear from the east of Madīnah that is Iraq and areas to the east. However, according to authentic narrations, that will be mentioned later, the Dajjāl will appear in the city of Asfahān (Isfahan), in Iran.

The Antichrist: His Religion, Description and Deeds

Jewish sources indicate that Antichrist is to be born in Babylon and of Jewish parents. Other sources indicate that the Antichrist will appear from east of the land of Persia. "It is probable also that the Antichrist shall come from the eastern parts of the land of Persia, where is the tribe of Dan of the Hebrew race."

However, many hadīths assure that the Dajjal is a Jew. Imām Muslim narrated that Abu Sa'īd Al-Khudrī said,
